- 1) Sally Hughes opened the meeting with the Pastoral Council's Prayer.
- 2) K. Bucciantini asked for a motion to approve the agenda. L. Bellipanni moved, B. Taylor seconded.
- 3) Fr. Ken opened his remarks addressing the Capital Campaign, stating it will continue to be addressed in a timely fashion.
- 4) In regard to St. Fabian Chapel of Ease, Fr. Ken stated that property on Cole Rd. was still under consideration and advisement, and that the property originally considered for St. Fabian's on Hwy. 589 is separate from the school.
- 5) K. Bucciantini asked for a motion to approve previous minutes from January and C. Landrum asked that corrections be made before approval. Note Changes: a) "School construction" was incorrectly inserted in regard to the 589 property. The minutes should reflect that the 589 property was not suitable for construction; b) Vicki

Flanagan participates in Pastoral Council Ex-Officio. After noting changes, G. Brust moved to approve the previous minutes, and his motion was seconded.

- 6) S. Hughes gave a Facilities update.
- 7) L. Bellipanni reported on the upcoming fundraiser for SHS. S. Hughes asked that the council approve the dates Sept. 24 & 25 for the Seafood Jamboree. G. Brust motioned the council approve the dates and the motion was seconded. K. Bucciantini suggested parishioners interested in volunteering, report to the established committees for Seafood Jamboree. Fr. Ken suggested that St. Thomas parishioners be included in committees as well.
- 8) R. Meyers thanked S. Hughes & K. Bucciantini for coordinating parent volunteers for Sunday evening Youth Ministry.
- 9) Reporting for B. McCrory, V. Flanagan stated that Faculty at SHS were enthusiastic about potential expansion on Pine St, noting interested families not currently registered have requested information and tours.
- 10) J. Beckett updated the council on the Parish Mission including the Hispanic Ministry Mission.
- 11) Fr. Ken urged council members to attend the Stewardship Seminar on March 6th, 10 am - 12pm, along with the Administration & Finance, and Stewardship committees.
- 12) Damian Mercier commented on publicity for the Pine St. property proposal.
- 13) R. Sanchez asked for prayerful consideration of upcoming training and preparation of Hispanic Youth Ministers.
- 14) Fr. Ken asked for volunteers after Masses to man the religious articles case.
- 15) The council is set to meet next on March 17<sup>th</sup> at 6pm.
