I) Josh Hyde opened with the Pastoral Council prayer.

II) Kay Bucciantini opened floor to approve agenda. Bruce Launey moved to approve and Josh Hyde seconded; all approved

III) Fr. Ken reported that the campaign was just below \$1.2 million. The Development Committee is moving forward with the Pine St. property. The upcoming appraisal of that property is of considerable consequence and Fr. Ken asked that the council keep that in our intentions and prayers. With no major foreseeable obstacles, the school has begun to purchase new equipment. With 405 families registered, and 625 students, the school is closing in on its goal of 429 families and 655 students. A contract involving property on

Cole Rd. will be signed by Bishop Morin. The zoning of property on Hwy. 589 will be addressed so as to help the sale of that property

IV) Kay Bucciantini asked for approval of previous Pastoral Council minutes. Bruce Launey moved, Josh Hyde seconded; all approved

V) Kay Bucciantini asked for approval of all ministry minutes. Sally Hughes moved, Beth Taylor seconded; all approved.

VI) Sally Hughes reported that repairs on pews should begin this week, as materials had arrived. Sally also reported that the Read-a-thon made \$18,000. The Rock N Roux helped conclude the week long Read-A-thon during which SHS students read 120,500 minutes. With Rock N Roux over, progress will begin on the Seafood Jamboree. Brian McCrory reported that student numbers are up at SHS. Eight new teachers have been hired, with prospects of hiring eight more. Two assistants have been hired, with two more assistant positions to fill, as well as a position for a receptionist. The SHS Baseball team is District Champs; the SHS Tennis team is District Champs; the Mock Trial team will compete for the National Title in Philadelphia, PA.

VII) Discussion was opened for new business. Fr. Ken reported that on May 23rd the 8am, 10:30am, and Baccalaureate Masses would combine for one outdoor Mass to possibly be held at the nearby downtown park, or on church property. Brian McCrory stated that he would encourage all SHS graduating seniors including non-Catholics to participate in the Baccalaureate Mass. Names of several parishioners were mentioned as potential council members for the Nomination committee to consider.

VIII) May's Pastoral Council meeting will include wine and cheese. Each member should bring cheese and crackers to share. Parish will provide wine. Fr. stated that two seminarians, Ignatius Morales and David Mora, will be at Sacred Heart Parish this summer, and will be accommodated at the rectory. Kay Bucciantini inquired about seminarian, Satish from India, who, according to Fr. Ken, was unable to work out plans to be here. Kay also commended Michael Marascalco, who is a seminarian that was here to serve during Holy Week. Fr. Ken remarked he loved being here. Rafael Sanchez commended the Hispanic youth on their presentation of The Way of The Cross encouraging members to attend next year's presentation.

IX) Cheri closed the meeting with a prayer and the meeting was adjourned.
